"Hey! I heard you guys talking about Christianity."

***a story from one of our staff in Colombia.

As part of being on staff with Cru, we get trainings that help us to do the best work possible on the field while we trust in the Holy Spirit and what he is doing wherever we are. This past month, two missionaries from Brazil came to Colombia and taught us more about "Catalytic Strateay".

The desire is to work together to build movements in different campuses through exploring challenging, and coaching key volunteers to become multiplying disciples. After our training, we went to one of the campuses I work at. The goal was to talk to as many students you can and ask them if they are Christian or know someone who is. I started walking around with my partner René (a Guatemalan staff) asking students and hearing a lot of "no's". Then we approached 2 others students who said no but then someone behind me called me out and told me: "Hey! I heard you guys talking about Christianity. Could you tell me more?"

This student was Juan, a law student that told us he has been exploring Christianity for the past 3 months. We sat together for a while, and we shared about Jesus and his heart for reaching the campuses and the world. When we got back to the hotel to share about our experiences, we found out we talked to 800 students and only 10 of them were Christians. I realized that we have unreached people even in open countries like Colombia and around the world. How can this be possible? How are there students that haven't heard the gospel or talked to someone who truly follows Jesus? That's why we want to see the Gospel for every student, a movement for every campus and multiplying disciples in and for every nation.
